FAITH ALONE

The expedition has had no advance representatives arranging where the members shall stay during their tour. They are crossing the Atlantic furnished with nothing except their own faith that "Where God guides He provides.''

How the members of the party are to live during their pilgrimage was summed up in that way by the Rev. John Roots, of London
