

M.Ps. MEET CAST OF PLAY

CAPETOWN, Friday.

Members of both Houses of Parliament attended a meeting in the Senate library today to meet the cast of "The Forgotten Factor," the moral rearmament play recently presented in Capetown.

The Speaker, Mr. J. F. T. Naude, presided over the meeting, which was initiated by Mr. C. M. van Coller, former Speaker and M.P. for Queenstown.

Representatives of the major political Parties present were introduced to the cast by Mr. Bremer Hofmeyr, of Capetown, who said: "This is an ideological age."

"The democracies have to learn the art of ideological warfare. While other ideologies are on the march and infiltrating our nations, moral rearmament is putting democracy on the offensive with the power of a superior ideology."

The Under-Secretary for Education in the North Rhine-Westphalia, Dr. Otto Koch, reporting on the visit of "The Forgotten Factor" to the Ruhr, said he had found a new sense of cooperation with his Minister, a member of an opposing political Party, and added: "This is possible only on a higher level, on the platform we have found for our country through moral rearmament."
