

MORAL REARMAMENT "A BIG FORCE IN S.A."

45 Full-Time Workers

MORAL REARMAMENT had become a big force in Southern Africa, said Mr. W. Andrew Strang in an interview with the *Cape Times* yesterday.

Mr. Strang, a Scot, is one of 45 men now working full-time for Moral Rearmament in this country. A report on the sixth annual World Assembly for Moral Rearmament was published in the *Cape Times* yesterday.

"We believe that everyone must change, so that men may live by the four absolute standards of honesty, purity, unselfishness and love, and that they accept the guidance of God in personal, social, economic and racial relationships," he said.

Leaders of ideologies which said "My race" or "My class shall rule" were all being won over to democracy by the ideology of Moral Rearmament.

M.P.S' INTEREST

Increasing interest was being taken in Moral Rearmament in South African political circles. No fewer than six M.P.s had attended the World Assembly at Caux, including Mr. J. F. T. Naude, Minister of Posts and Telegraphs.

"We are building up an economic philosophy based on the fact that there is enough in the world for everyon's need, but not for everyone's greed," said Mr. Strang.
