Later the Board of Supervisors passed a motion urging the use of school buses for transporting students to the show in Hollywood Bowl, issued instructions that the 49,000 County employees be notified about the Show, and ordered that a plaque be placed at the Bowl honouring the late Dr. Frank Buchman who from that platform (on July 1939) launched Moral Re-Armament in America.
